

Current Status IDD&E

- Year 9 of the Program
- PADEP (Jan 2013)

- Application submitted to extend NPDES Permit to March 2018






IDD&E - Dry Weather Inspection










IDD&E Inspections, Sampling & Results - 2012

- Focused Inspections & Sampling on Area 2
- Historical "Hot Spot" Sampling Area 1
- Sample Analysis
 - Fecal coliform at all locations (Area 2 = 36 / Area 1 = 12)
 - Detergents at one location (Area 2)
- Data Review
- Detailed Mapping of Area 2
 - EPA requirement to map all outfalls, catch basins, etc.
 - Identify receiving waters / surrounding municipalities
 - Prepare detailed CAD map
- Annual Report (2011) to PADEP June 2012

IDD&E Sampling - 2012


Area 2

Outfalls

- 36 samples at 33 outfalls
- 15 samples (14 locations) FC > 200 col/100 ml
- Maximum FC = >6,000 col/100 ml



Area 2 - Sampling Results





IDD&E Sampling - 2012

Area 2

Fecal Coliform levels are elevated in sections of Area 2

Area 1

Fecal Coliform levels still elevated in hot spot areas of Area 1 but results did not increase (as may have been expected due to 3rd year of septic pump-out schedule)

Going Forward

- Complete round of outfall inspections and sampling in Area 3
- Detailed mapping of Area 3
- "Hot Spot" sampling in Areas 1 and 2 with historical FC impact
- Additional source investigations (i.e. dye tracing, TV inspection), if necessary
- Source mitigation, if identified



Takeaways

- Township in Compliance
- Continue Inspections/Sampling
- Complete mapping effort
- Continue to perform sampling where illicit discharges may be occurring
- Septic system maintenance
- Public participation
- Pollution prevention & good housekeeping
- Goal is to Improve Water Quality!!!



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
