Parkway Dedication

Ms. Mason updated everyone that there would be a meeting on April 19 at 2:00pm. The hope is to have the dedication on September 16, 2012 with a Roll 'n Stroll, food booths, information booths and hopefully be able to go to Horsham Road, if that is not possible because Blooming Glen is not finished then we will need to go to Bristol Road.

Fund Raising will be needed and will be under way soon.

Neshaminy Greenway Trail DVRPC

Still waiting on the paperwork from Phase I, the wetlands for Phase II are being mapped. We need to have a meeting with representatives from Lenape Valley Soccer, John Schmidt, New Britain Borough and Township probably Chalfont and invite them to a meeting to discuss Phase II & III of the plan and getting across Upper State Road. Ms. Mason will coordinate setting up a meeting.

The concern is that the Township did not receive Phase II funding but Buck County did for the Neshaminy Greenway but going east not west as it is our intent to go. Ms. Mason will call Chris Lynn at DVRPC and confirm.

DCNR Grant Destination Peace Valley

The grant application went in, will need to finalize the easements with the County and most likely a wetland study will need to be done on a portion but we won't know anything on that grant application until the fall.

We are going to move forward with the HOP and access to the 202 Parkway with PennDot and hopefully move that along, Chris Stanford will set up a meeting.

There was also a discussion perhaps getting bike lanes to go from Lower State all the way to Poole's Corner.

CMAC & DVRPC

Becoming available for construction design but you really need a ready to go project. There is a 20% match; it is transit dependent, bicycle lanes. Mr. Stanford suggested that we hold off on this.

Silhouettes

Ms. Hendrixson indicated that there is some difficulty with the students completing the silhouettes as they are extra credit and none of them have been interested. We need to find someone else to help supplement.

Kiosks

There was discussion about having a kiosk at Lower State Road and the Parkway, with signage in an area where we could provide information as well.
