Phase 1 Update:

Ms. Mason provided a brief update on the progress of Phase 1 Pebble Ridge/Woodridge Sewer Project. She indicated that BCWSA is progressing with the project. They've made the connection to the Castle Valley Interceptor line and are working their way up the Both driveway on Almshouse. Militia Hill has been saw cut. Due to the deep rock a redesign for an elevated pipe is being reviewed by PA DEP. Once available this will aide in allowing the project to move more quickly. Reimbursements from the Penn Vest Loan for work that has been completed on clearing and pump station have been submitted and received.

Mr. Van Houten, Mr. Salanik and Ms. Mullin, residents from the neighborhood, along with Mr. Stone, Mr. Colello, Mr. Wallace, Ms. Mason, Mr. Butler from BCWSA and Mr. Matticola from Gilmore Assoc., have been meeting periodically to review progress and address the payments. Information is on the Township and BCWSA websites with updates being made as needed.

A mailing was sent to the residents with phone numbers and where to obtain information.

Phase 2 & 3 Feasibility Study:

Mr. Van Houten sent email copies of the feasibility study from BCWSA for Phase 2/3 for review and future discussion by the PWSAB.

Next meeting: February 21, 2019.

Mr. Canterbury invited a representative from Lower Salford Township Authority to come and share their experience in installing sewers in their community

Adjournment: Being no further business those present adjourned the meeting.
