- Blythe requested only new info be included in the Board Packet update.
- Karen shared a standard shelter Concept for consideration by the PRB. She noted that standard pavilion design, like the benches, could be used for all parks going forward. She noted it would complement the park plan and simplify the process in the future and better ensure uniformity and make style decisions easier. May also provide naming opportunity possibility.

Don B. asked if other vendors be considered. Karen noted that this was the same vendor who the Township worked with relative to the benches and that they are on Costars (cooperative purchasing).

It was noted that the Potential cost, all inclusive, \$70,000.00 for a 16' x 24' pavilion. Paul D. asked if it could be wrapped for inclement weather – Karen noted that it would likely be a custom design but should be able to be done.

Following discussion, the PRB consensus was to utilize the standard shelter concept.

The Park & Rec Board recommends for consideration a right of way be requested between the Bridgepoint Park property and County Property for potential park use. Recommendation was also made to request a sidewalk be installed in front of the property on Rt 611 for building access for pedestrians. An additional request made that the Bike and Hike Committee review potential for connecting Bridgepoint Park to the Almshouse B&H path.
