All Doylestown Township fields are available for seasonal use by local athletic organizations and open to the public as available or by reservation. To obtain seasonal use of a field, complete and submit a Field Use Application to info@doylestownnpa.org. Seasonal Applications can be found online at doylestownrec.org. Field reservations must be paid for prior to use.

- Athletic fields are available to rent seasonally from March 17–June 1, June 9–August 24 and September 1–November 16. Athletic fields are closed for field preservation from Mid-November–March with individual fields closed annually for restoration.
