Doylestown has over 30 miles of completed hiking trails and is committed to expanding them to weave naturally through our beautiful park systems and neighborhoods. For more information and a printable trail map, visit doylestownrec.org and click the “trails” tab.

Kids’ Castle Group Days

Group visits are no longer offered at Kids’ Castle. Organized groups of any size, including nonprofits, camps, schools, or daycare groups, are not permitted. Any groups arriving on site will be asked to leave, and enforcement assistance may be requested if necessary. Kids’ Castle remains open to individual families and the public during regular hours. This change helps manage capacity, maintain safety, and ensure a positive experience for all visitors. There are no plans currently to reinstate Group Days or organized group visits.

Athletic Field and Facility Reservations

Doylestown Township has many athletic fields suitable for seasonal, occasional, and tournament play. Doylestown Township fields are available for seasonal use by local athletic organizations and open to the public as available or by reservation. To obtain seasonal use of a field, complete and submit a Field Use Application to info@doylestownpa.org. Seasonal Applications can be found online at doylestownrec.org. Field reservations must be paid for prior to use.

- Athletic fields are available to rent seasonally from March 16–May 31, June 1–August 23 and August 24–November 15. Athletic fields are closed for field preservation from Mid-November–March. Central Park Field #3 will be closed for athletic use in 2026 for rest and maintenance.

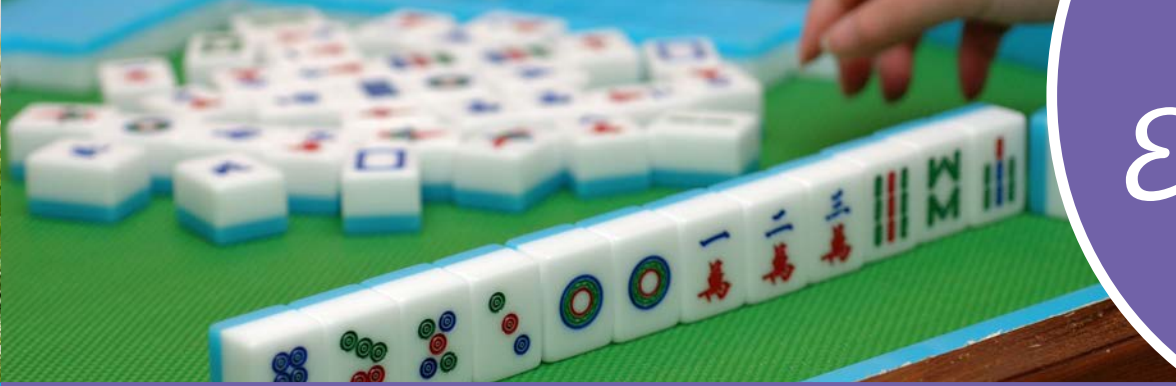
Central Park 9-Hole Disc Golf Course

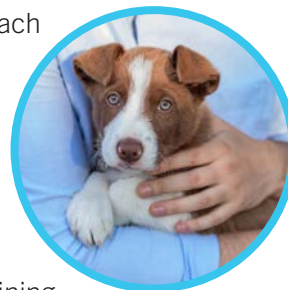

Dogs in Parks

We welcome your well-mannered canine friends. Dogs must always be leashed and under the control of their owner. Off-leash activity is prohibited. Owners are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of waste material.

Shared Use Trails

Understanding Shared-Use Trail Etiquette can make trails more enjoyable for everyone, it's important that you understand trail etiquette. Follow these steps:

- **Respect other users; expect other users.** Show courtesy. Respect wildlife. Respect public & private property. Leave no trace.
- **Be friendly and courteous.** Greet other folks with a simple "Hello!" or "Nice day today!"
- **Bicyclists should yield to everyone.** Runners yield to walkers. Downhill traffic yields to uphill traffic. When in doubt, give other users the right way.
- **Announce yourself when approaching others,** especially from behind. If you're in a group, avoid blocking the trail.
- **Stay on the trail.** Creating your own path or cutting switchbacks creates erosion, damages habitat and natural resources.
- **Always operate within your ability.** Remember that situations can get out-of-control fast if you're not attentive!
- **Be considerate,** keep dogs always leashed and under control. Other trail users don't know your dog is friendly.
- **Bring water, snacks, maps, and other equipment** you may need. Know where you're going and tell someone else your plan.

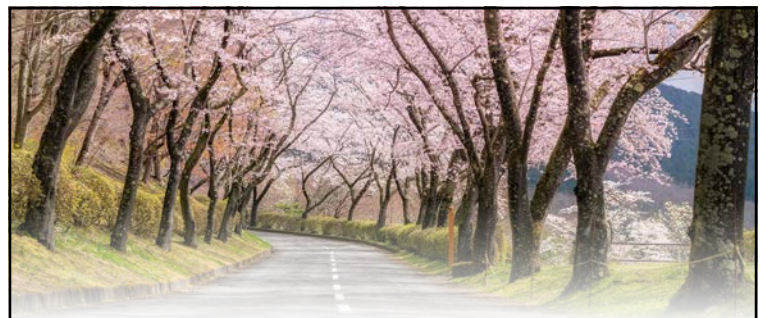
