

New to Doylestown Township?

See the New Resident Requirements!

Doylestown Township currently does NOT require a Use & Occupancy permit/inspection for residential resales. This means that our Code Enforcement Department will not be inspecting your property and there are no permit fees involved in the purchase of your new home. However, since we do not require these types of inspections, it can become difficult for us to know when ownership changes. This is why it's very important for our new residents to be sure they have filed a Deed Registration and Move-In Permit with the Township's Code Enforcement Office.

DEED REGISTRATION

Doylestown Township Ordinance 218 requires that when a residential or commercial property is sold a copy of the new deed is required to be registered with the Township using the Deed Registration Form. The fee is \$10. If you submit the Deed and Registration Form with the \$10 fee by mail, enclose a self-addressed envelope if you wish a receipt. Many times your title company will do this for you at closing, in the event that they may not have, please feel free to contact the Township Administration Offices to confirm.

MOVE-IN-PERMIT

Doylestown Township Ordinance Number 258 requires that all people moving into the Township register with the Township using the Move-In-Permit registration form which can be printed here. Landlords are to register the names and ages of all their tenants that move into rental properties and update the information if ten-

→ Fluoride is not added to the water.

→ In order to maintain compliance with Federal, State and Local regulations for supply and distribution of potable water, the Authority authorized a change in water rate. Starting in 2017, the rate per 1,000 gallons will be \$5.85. The changes go into effect with the first quarter billing January, 1, 2017.

The Doylestown Township Municipal Authority (DTMA) has a new high speed mass communication and notification system. 

Septage Management Program

About the Program

On January 16, 2001, the Board of Supervisors approved Ordinance No. 299, an On-Lot Sewage Disposal System (OLDS) Management Ordinance. A copy of this Ordinance is available at the township.

Ordinance No. 299 requires all Doylestown Township residents with on-lot sewage disposal systems to have their systems pumped and inspected by an approved pumper/hauler/installer every three years (please see the attached list of registered service providers). The service provider will send us a copy of your inspection report.

The ordinance was adopted to assist homeowners to ensure the successful present and future operation of existing OLDS. This program will help protect your health and safety, as well as the wellbeing of your neighbors. The routine inspection and pumping of your OLDS may also have the long-term benefit of lessening costly repairs/replacements.

Residents also must have their well water tested for coli form (bacteria E-coli) during the same calendar year as they pump (please see the attached list of certified water testing laboratories). You are responsible for mailing a copy of the results of your water tests to us via mail, fax or email.

What Cycle Are You In?

Cycle I: Pebble Ridge (Bounded by Bristol and Upper State Roads, to Turk and Almshouse Road)

Cycle II: Pebble Hill I, II, III/Wilshire (Bounded by Rt. 611 to Rt. 313 and Rt. 202)

Cycle III: Tedwill and Pine Valley (Bounded by Rt. 313 and the 611 Bypass, Ferry Road and Iron Hill Road and the New Britain Borough line)

When Should You Schedule Your Next Pump/Inspection?

Cycle I: 2019, 2022, 2025, 2028 ... every three years

Cycle II: 2020, 2023, 2026, 2029 ... every three years

Cycle III: 2018, 2021, 2024, 2027 ... every three years





Central Park is also home to the Covenant Bank Amphitheater which hosts the Thompson Performing Arts Series.
- * In addition to Central Park, Parks & Rec also have Turk Park I (baseball fields & football field), Turk Park II (baseball fields, multi-purpose fields, fitness trail, playground, and volleyball court), Turk Park III (Dog Park, and multi-purpose fields), Bridge Point Park (grounds), Castel Valley Park (nature trail), and Sauerman Park (baseball field, woodland trail, and picnic area).

Along with the wonderful park systems, our Park & Rec Department also offers a wide variety of programs all year round to residents and non-residents of Doylestown Township.
