New Business

- Lt Logan presented a summary of the traffic counter statistics over the summer.
 - The counter software deemed Willow Lane a low priority.
 - There have been requests made by Chief White to Buckingham and Warwick to run traffic details on Sugarbottom Rd. There does not appear to be any response.
 - In May of 2011, there was a complaint from a resident on South Woodridge regarding traffic volume and speeding. The average speed was 29 (posted 25), 85th percentile is 36 mph. There is a petition with 22 signatures asking for action. Dave M will invite them to the meeting to discuss.
 - Sauerman: it's too soon to decide to do something. We need to give the lowered speed limit more time.

- Castle Valley Bridge construction status
 - Verizon is late moving fiber optic lines due to their strike. PennDOT is not committing to any timeframe for construction to move forward.
- Turk Rd @ Kutz Elementary
 - This is in the Supervisors hands at this point.
- **Motion** by Mark to request the Board of Supervisors to reallocate money from traffic calming funds to purchase two more traffic counters (amount to be supplied by Lt Logan) to assist with traffic calming efforts in the township, second Dave. Passed unanimously.
- Ed Neff: Intersection of Pebble Hill & Spring Valley, trees branches are blocking view of hill. Lt Logan will look into it.
